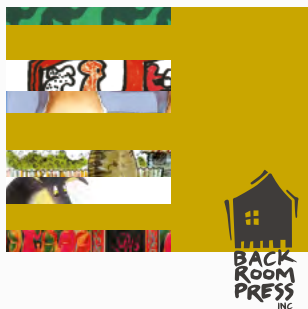
A FESTIVAL OF WORDS 2020
